We are proud to honour Jude's memory via this new award, which aims to help foster expertise and resilience in the next generation of female leaders.



ABOUT THE AWARD



The Award will be provided to two recipients who identify as female in recognition of their contribution to the community of people who use drugs.



The Award includes a mentorship program – a unique professional development opportunity which supports emerging female leaders and celebrates advocacy efforts internationally. The mentor program will be delivered by INPUD, tailored to the awardees, and co-created together. There will be \$10,000 USD per awardee allocated to supporting participation in the program.



Awardees will also receive a full scholarship to attend the INHSU 2022 conference.
