

Pandemic Treaty timeline



22nd - 28th May 2022

World Health Assembly

- Organise and/or participate in side events
- Brief member states on civil society engagement in the treaty process, and on the substantive elements you think should be included

6th - 8th June 2022

Continuation of 1st INB Session

- Reach out to INB Member States, WHO, UN Agencies and Non-State Actors in Official relations of WHO, giving them recommendations on the substantive elements of the treaty and expansion of civil society and community participation in the process



16th - 17th June 2022

Public hearings to collect inputs on a working draft

- Coordinate with civil society colleagues through the Pandemic Treaty Advocacy Google Group (pandemictreatyadv@googlegroups.com)
- Share this information among your networks, including by translating it into local languages
- Organise national civil society briefings to share information about the process and strategize around the key issues and recommendations that should be provided
- Participate through written submissions; and/or public statements
- Encourage other involved actors (such as UN agencies, Observers, Non-State Actors in Official Relations with WHO) to echo your messages

July 2022

2nd INB Meeting:

Potential consideration of a working draft

- Reach out to INB Member States, WHO, UN Agencies and Non-State Actors in Official relations of WHO, giving them recommendations on the text of the working draft (if any)



August - October 2022

Regional committee meetings and consultations

- Push for meaningful, formal civil society participation in the consultations
- Share this information among your networks, including by translating it into local languages
- Coordinate with colleagues from your region for strong participation and unified messages
- Encourage other involved actors to echo your messages (e.g. UN agencies, Observers, Non-State Actors in Official Relations with WHO); including by organising pre- and post-consultation briefings
