Refresher: Important Shifts for Harm Reduction in Grant Cycle 7

- Intensified focus on prevention across HTM
- Greater focus on program interventions to address health inequity, human rights and gender-related barriers
- New minimum expectations for community engagement (CE) at different stages across the grant cycle
- Harm reduction is an explicit "HIV program essential"
- The Community and Civil Society Annex
- HIV and HBV and HCV interventions for people who use and/or inject drugs
- RSSH module includes significant space for community systems strengthening activities
- Significant number of new and updated CRG technical guidance materials that outline the priorities ("the what") and implementation strategies ("the how")
